The reunion will be held the weekend of June 20 - 22, 2014 in Reidsville, N. C.

The Reidsville/Ruffin area was the homeplace of John/Ruth Cloud Thrasher and their family (sons Joseph Cloud Thrasher, Isaac/Ruth Barton Thrasher and John/Susan Barton Thrasher during the Revolutionary War.

Just a few miles to the SW of Reidsville is where another branch of our family lived during the Revolution. There lived William William Thrasher, the earliest ancestor of the Tennessee Thrasher/Threshers. It would be fun to seek out his homesite too.

Local attractions are the Lick Fork Baptist Church (land donated by Joseph Cloud Thrasher), the Guilford County Battlefield Site, and the Thrasher properties.

Joe has made reservations for a block of rooms at the Holiday Inn Express in Reidsville, N. C. Room rates are \$89 to \$93 per night plus 11% tax. A buffet dinner is being planned at a local restaurant for Saturday night. Shot in His Chair

by a young lawyer formerly a resident of Atlanta
and a woman the cause of it

The Mayor of Starke, Florida Killed in His Private Office
by A. B. Thrasher, who Confessed the Crime

A. B. Thrasher (Barton Albert Thrasher,) a young man once well known in Atlanta, figures in a very sensational shooting affray in Gainesville, Florida, last Wednesday. He shot and killed Mayor Witkouski, of Starke, Florida, in his private office. Thrasher gave himself up and is now in the hands of the sheriff.

It has been about ten years since Thrasher, a member of the firm Ashby & Thrasher, was a citizen of Atlanta. He was then only a boy, fourteen or fifteen years old, but at that age he had already made a reputation for wildness. He was well connected, a son of the senior member of the law firm of B. H. & A. M. Thrasher, then doing an extensive practice. His father is dead, but his uncle A. M. Thrasher, is at present Mayor of Sanford, Florida, one of the foremost citizens of the state. Besides being prominently connected in Florida, Thrasher is related distantly to several influential Atlanta families.

The Gainesville killing is of a very mysterious and shocking nature, and created a great deal of excitement in that section.

Thrasher's career

A gentleman who was familiar with young Thrasher and his family said yesterday when acquainted with the facts: "He was always what you would call a wild boy. After his father moved to Florida, he was sent away to Tennessee to school to keep him from mischief. There he got into a muss and to keep from being expelled ran away, coming to Atlanta where he got hold of enough money to take him back home. Mr. Thrasher never knew of his son's running away from college to the day of his death. While he was wild, Thrasher was exceptionally bright, and I have heard him express some very high ideas of honor. The killing appears to have been cold blooded, but the explanation may clear it up and present the young lawyer in a better light."

Those who were acquainted with Thrasher are not surprised at the affair if, as stated, the good name of a woman is at stake.

Descendants of George Thrasher (1780 - 1851)

So much of the genealogy we work with is concerned with the past -- the real past. I've spent so much time working with family research from the 1700s, 1800s, & 1900s that it is very refreshing to have Montana Thrasher and his wife, Whitney, become a part of the Thrasher Family Association and to be documenting and seeking answers to family matters and genealogy within his own life time as well as the "past."

I'm sure those of you who were privileged to attend the Thrasher Reunion last May in Athens, Georgia, enjoyed meeting Montana and Whitney and viewing the material he presented concerning his father.

Montana was seeking a connection to anyone already tested in the TFA's DNA project, but so far there are no matches. As you know, we have already identified several different and distinct Thrasher family lines within our membership, but we need more Thrasher males to be tested in the effort to create other links. If you know someone who is eligible for testing, please encourage him to contact Nancy Cherry or me for information.

Perhaps too, you have some research materials that might shed new light on this interesting family.

The Newsletter of the Mid-Atlantic- Thrasher Association Volume 9, Issue 2 details the dedication of John Quincy Adams Thrasher's new military headstone, as well as his Thrasher genealogy. John Q.A. Thrasher was the 8th child of George and Mary Catherine "Polly" Nance. In a statement provided to Dr. Marion Thrasher for the purpose of his book The Thrasher Family, John Q.A. Thrasher states that his grandfather immigrated to America from Germany (Johann Christoph Drescher, AKA Christopher Stoffel/Stophel Thrasher). John then states that his father (George Thrasher) was born in Pennsylvania, moved to Maryland at 2 years of age, and then onto Botetourt County, where he lived the remainder of his life. John then mentions living siblings Adeline Zimmerman, Mary McCartney, Susan Firebaugh. John then goes on to mention that he has two nephews in merchandising in Springwood, Botetourt County, VA, name W.T. Thrasher (great-great-grandfather of Montana Jason Thrasher), and J.M. Thrasher.

Wallace Samuel Thrasher(James Lacy, James William, William Taylor, William Powell, George) was born June 27th, 1940 in Roanoke County, Roanoke, Virginia, and is missing and presumed dead since November 1984. He married Olga Lillie Wright on December 21st 1977 at Hotel Roanoke, Roanoke County, Roanoke, Virginia. Married by the Mayor of Roanoke, Virginia. Olga was born on December 12th 1956 in Azores, Portugal, and is currently living in Gainesville, Georgia.

Graduated from Pulaski High School June 1958. Was a standout football player for the Pulaski Orioles, and earned the nickname squirrel for his ability to outrun trouble on the football field.

United States Navy 1958-1964, both active duty and reserve.

Attended private flight training school in Roanoke, Virginia 1967-68

Was a charter pilot from 1969-1984. From the early 1970's until 1984, Wallace was a transporter of Marijuana, smuggling it into the United States from the Bahamas, Mexico, and Central America.

Wallace fought a Gorilla named Butch at the Virginia State Fair on August 15th 1970. He was given a football helmet as protection, but unfortunately had the helmet taken away from him by the Gorilla, who proceeded to use it against Wallace. Wallace stood his ground however, and received a handsome certificate from Noel's Ape Fighting.

Wallace has been missing and presumed dead since November 1984, following an incident where one of his planes was that was transporting marijuana, was involved in an accident on Fancy Gap Mountain, Virginia. Wallace was not in the plane at the time of the accident, however the plane did belong to him, and so to the authorities, he became a prime suspect in the case.

Wallace left Virginia for Belize, Central America in late October 1984, in order to reimburse his associates, or to buy more marijuana, and was never seen again. There have been reports that he may have been double crossed by his associates and killed, or that he perished in a plane crash after his plane was sabotaged by his associates.

Wallace's case was profiled on Unsolved Mysteries in February 1995, and America's Most Wanted in February and June 2010, March 2011, and March 2012.

Notes for Olga Lillie Wright:

Olga was born in Azores, Portugal on Dec 12th 1956 to Maria do Carmo da Silva, and an unknown father. Olga's given name was Olga Maria da Silva. She was adopted by Wilbur (Bill), and Maria Wright, from her mother in 1962. The adoption was due in part to hardships (lack of work, support etc.) being experienced by Olga's mother at that time. Olga later reestablished a relationship with her mother, and several siblings.
