My mother, the widow of George Martin Thrasher (1913-1992), was born in Blocton, Bibb, Alabama, September 9, 1916 and died in Birmingham, Jefferson, Alabama, July 5, 2002. She and my father were married 18 July, 1937, in West Blocton, Alabama. They had one child, Helen Raye Thrasher, born February 15, 1939, in West Blocton. My mother began schooling me from an early age in math, reading, spelling, and love for life and everyone. I lasted 10 days in first grade and later even skipped tenth grade on the way to a three year stay at the University of Alabama and eight years at the Medical College of Alabama and University Hospital and Hillman Clinic in Birmingham, where I specialized in Ophthalmology. My mother began working for a children's clothing manufacturer when I was a high

school senior, and spent all of her earnings for my education for the next 11 years. She was my teacher, coach, best friend, and confidant.

George Martin Thrasher, my father, was a terrific husband, and supported my mother in all of her endeavors. My parents never met my husband, John Bryant Long, Jr. (1925-), but would have loved him as dearly as I do.

MARGARET ADELIA THRASHER (1855 - 1936)

My great-great grandfather, Robert Knight Thrasher, had six children who lived to adulthood. Two of his four sons married and had families. The other two sons and his two daughters remained single. Margaret Adelia Thrasher, known as Aunt Delie, was one of the daughters.

One of her married brothers, Thomas Souder Thrasher, was widowed when his daughter Anna Margaret Thrasher was only 11 and his son Thomas Lakin Thrasher (my grandfather) was 8. Delie stepped in to help her brother rear the children. When Thomas Souder Thrasher died eight years later, Delie's bachelor brother Benjamin Albert Thrasher became guardian of Thomas Lakin Thrasher, then 16, and Delie continued in her role as caretaker and confidante to both Thomas Lakin and Anna Margaret.

Because she left no direct descendants, Delie is destined to be forgotten when those of us who heard our parents and grandparents speak of her are gone. She left behind fond memories, some recipes, particularly one for her blackberry cordial, which I now make, and at least one delightful story :

In their later years, Delie and her sister moved to a home in the town of Jefferson, across the street from the bank where their brother Benjamin Albert Thrasher was president. When electricity came to the town, Delie's home was electrified, but her great-niece, my Aunt Bunny, remembers being fearful as a child when she visited her great-aunts because their house was dark, shadowy, and lit by oil lamps. Bunny was told that she could not turn on the electric light because Aunt Delie and Aunt Treasie were afraid they would "use up the electricity."

In Memoriam



William Wright Woodruff

William Wright Woodruff "Woody" of Alexandria, Virginia, age 91, died on January 1, 2016. Mr. Woodruff was a former Assistant Secretary of the United States Air Force, a military veteran, civil servant and a corporate executive. Mr. Woodruff was a resident of Mount Vernon, Virginia for more than 50 years. He was married for 56 years to the former Mildred Ardelia Comer of Lawrenceburg, Tennessee, who died in 2007. At an early age, Mr. Woodruff moved with his family from his birthplace in McDonough, Georgia to Lawrenceburg, Tennessee. In 1943, immediately upon

his graduation from Lawrence County High School, he was inducted into the U.S. Army Air Corps. He was among the first group of eighteen year-olds in the nation drafted into military service. Mr. Woodruff was assigned to Glaser's B-24 Liberator Crew as a radio operator and completed 34 combat missions over Germany. After his military service, Mr. Woodruff earned his bachelor's degree from Middle Tennessee State College in 1948. He continued his education with a law degree from Vanderbilt University in 1950. Mr. Woodruff practiced law briefly before he was appointed by Sen. Kenneth McKellar (TN) to the staff of the Secretary of the United States Senate. Beginning in 1961, he joined the staff of the Senate Appropriations Committee, where he served until 1973, retiring as Counsel to the Committee. In March of that year, he was confirmed as Assistant Secretary of the Air Force for Financial Management, and in 1975, received the Air Force Exceptional Civilian Award, the highest award conferred upon Air Force civilian employees. He then worked for Hughes Aircraft Corporation for the next 14 years, retiring in 1989. Mr. Woodruff became an early member of the Aldersgate United Methodist Church and continued his affiliation with the congregation until his death. He was an avid golfer and enjoyed reading books on military and political history. In addition to his late wife, he was also predeceased by his two brothers, Idus (Ike) M. Woodruff and James (Red) Nicholas Woodruff. Survivors include Kimberley Woodruff Engle and her husband Mark Engle of Alexandria and numerous nieces and nephews in Alabama, Georgia, and Tennessee.

The daughter-in-law of Ike Woodruff who lives in Griffin, Georgia and has remarried called to tell us of his death. There is more info on the Woodruff family in Aunt Vessie Mae's book on pages 142-148. Our own TFA member, Albert Thrasher of Tiger, Georgia is now the only remaining grandchild of Gus Thrasher.

He married FANNIE PALMER HOTCHKISS 03 December 1868 in Atlanta, Fulton Co. Ga.. She was born 23 May 1851 in Levy Co. Fla., and died 15 December 1937 in Atlanta, Fulton Co. Ga..

Notes for WILLIAM FREDERICK THRASHER:

1880 Census for Little Blue, Washington County, Kansas. Listed as William F. Thrasher with his family. He and Fannie had moved to St. Joseph, Buchanan County, Missouri where their daughter Monie Belle was born. They moved to Kansas to homestead, spending several years in Rooks County where several of the children were born.

1900 Census for St. Joseph, Buchanan County, Missouri. Fannie and the children had moved back to St. Joseph.

1910 Census for Washington, Buchanan County, Missouri. Frederick F. Thrasher was living alone.

His granddaughter Gladys Virginia Thrasher Peterson said: "Before William's death, Frances moved back to Atlanta, Ga. They had separated. William was reclusive & peculiar." -- just as his son Eric Furman Thrasher became.

He died of an accidental gunshot wound acquired in a rabbit drive by a shot from his own gun.

Eric was unmarried. In the 1910 Census for Atlanta, Fulton County, Georgia, he is listed as having "no occupation." In 1930 he is listed as "Caretaker, private home."

Eric lived all of his life with his mother and sisters.

US World War I Registration cards, 1917 - 1918: The registration (dated 5 June 1917) gives the following information: Age 23; born 14 Feb. 1894; natural birth; born in Stockton, Kansas; present occupation, he is a clerk; employed by R. G. Dunn & Co.; no family for whom he is responsible; single; no previous military service; signed Eric Thrasher; Eric was described as being tall, slender, having gray eyes & brown hair.

About 1940 or earlier, Eric & his sister Fannie visited my parents in Micanopy, Florida. They were invited for dinner. Eric acted very strange and during the meal, Fannie corrected him about something he did, not said. That's all that I remember about being with them. John E. Thrasher III

Missouri, and died February 1911 in Colorado Springs, El Paso Co. Colorado. He married (2) LUCY BENNETT Abt. 1912. She was born Abt. 1870 in Colorado, and died Abt. 31 May 1931 in Denver, Jefferson County, Colorado.

Death certificate, State file #1802, dated 14 Feb. 1941. States that he is buried in Bethel Cemetery, St. Joseph, Mo.

Thrasher, living in California; a daughter, Mrs. Gladys Peterson of Hillrose, Colorado; a brother Eric H. Thrasher of Atlanta, Georgia; and three sisters: Mrs. G. D. Whitlock, Miss Fannie Thrasher and Miss Birdie Thrasher all of Atlanta. The body is at Rupp Funeral Home."

The St. Joseph News-Press, 11 January 1941: Deaths: Thrasher - Earl L. Thrasher, aged 71, passed away Thursday, January 9, at a local hospital. Remains are at Rupp Funeral Home where funeral services will be conducted Thursday, Jan. 11 at 2 p. m. Rev. R. V. Price officiating. Burial Bethel Cemetery.

1900 Census for Wayne, Buchanan Co. Missouri. Earl & Betty, his wife, were living with her father Frederick Bunker and brother, John K. Bunker. Earl and Betty have been married one year.

1910 Census for St. Joseph, Buchanan Co. Missouri. Earl's name is mistranslated from the census as Pearl. With his are his wife Betty Anna and their three children& his sister Fannie Thrasher.

1920 Census for North Ft. Morgan, Morgan, Co. Colorado. His wife Betty Anna had died in 1911 and here he is listed with his second wife, Lucy B. Thrasher. Two of his children, Birdie & Raymond are living with them.

1930 Census for Wiggins, Buchanan Co. Missouri. Earl and Lucy are there together.

On 1 June 1931, Earl purchased the cemetery lot where Lucy is buried. This information is from Olinger's Funeral Home.

1920 Census for St. Joseph, Buchanan County, Missouri. Listed as Monie Whitlock.

Monie is a trimmer in a shirt factory. Her husband Garrett is manager of stock yards.

1930 Census for St. Joseph, Buchanan County, Missouri. Listed as Monnie Whitlock.

1940 Census for Long Beach, Los Angeles, California. Listed as Monie Whitlock. The census shows that in 1935 the Whitlocks were still living in St. Joseph, Missouri. Her schooling was 4th year of high school.

Missouri Marriage Records, 1805 - 2002: Miss Belle Thrasher; marriage date, 21 June 1900; Marriage location was St. Joseph, Buchanan County, Missouri; Spouse's name was Garrett D. Whitlock.

California Death Index, 1940 - 1997: Monie Belle Whitlock; Female; Birth date was 30 December 1874; Birth place, Missouri; Death date, 1 July 1951; Death place, was Los Angeles; father's surname was Thrasher.
